TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS

Please use the KWL chart as a part of your classroom instruction for the exhibit you have borrowed. The student instructions at the top of the chart should explain how to complete this assignment. You will need to collect the chart after the first part of the assignment and redistribute it when you have completed all of your activities related to the exhibit. Allow about 5 post-it notes for each student in each column. Using different colors for each column will make it easier to organize if any pieces fall off and it may make it more fun for the students.

We would appreciate having several examples of your students' work in this assignment to use for our student evaluation process. Having a random selection of this assignment from your classroom can help us learn about how we can better serve students and encourage learning through this area of our programming. Please include some samples of the chart complete with the post-it notes in the folder when you return the exhibit. If you would like to give us all of the student work from your classes, we'd be happy to have it.
